**Day 1:** Enjoy the beautiful scenery of Pennsylvania on your way to **New Jersey**. Visit the **Flight 93 National Memorial** in Shanksville, PA. Learn about the 40 passengers and crew whose actions thwarted the hijackers' plan to fly the plane to a target in Washington, D.C. It is a place to walk beside their final resting place and honor the extraordinary courage of those who fought back against the terrorists. Hotel for the next two nights is in Linden, NJ. (D)

**Day 2:** Start the day with a visit to the **9/11 Memorial Museum in New York City**. The Museum displays artifacts associated with the events of 9/11, while presenting stories of loss and recovery. Sit back and enjoy a **guided motorcoach tour of New York City**. **Getting off the motorcoach during the touring and walking a few blocks is required.** A superb dining experience will close out your day at one of **New York City's fine restaurants**. (B,D)

**Day 3:** This morning you will depart for **Ellis Island**. Enjoy a **view of the Statue of Liberty**, from the ferry, as you cruise to Ellis Island. Free time at the beautifully restored Ellis Island before departing for home. (B)

**Note: This tour is not suited for individuals with physical challenges or using walker/wheelchair. Requires mobility on your own to walk unassisted and keep up with the group. This is a strenuous walking tour and the motorcoach cannot drop you off right in front of the attractions. Walking several blocks, at a time, is required.**
