**Day 1:** Travel with **historian Kevin Green** to Michigan. Arrive at **The Henry Ford Museum and Greenfield Village**, which encompasses a collection of authentic artifacts and stories of America's ingenuity and innovation. Overnight in **Dearborn, MI.** (D)

**Day 2:** Enjoy the **Ford Factory Rouge Tour**. Get an inside look at the most iconic moments of American manufacturing history, and immerse yourself in modern manufacturing's most progressive concepts. Visit **Meijer Gardens and Sculpture Park**, a 158-acre botanical garden, art museum, and outdoor sculpture park before stopping at the **Grand Rapids Downtown Market**. Stay two nights in **Grand Rapids, MI.** (CB)

**Day 3:** This morning, visit the **Grand Rapids Public Museum**, which boasts one of Michigan's largest collections of artifacts that tell the stories of West Michigan. Enjoy a visit to the **Gerald R. Ford Presidential Museum** this afternoon. (B,D)

**Day 4:** Travel to **Saugatuck, MI** and experience it's natural beauty on a 40-minute dune ride across breathtaking sand dunes: **Saugatuck Dune Rides**. Next, visit the **Gilmore Car Museum**, the largest automobile museum in North America. Overnight in **Kalamazoo, MI.** (B)

**Day 5:** Homeward bound today, but there's more in store! Enjoy a visit to the **Air Zoo Aerospace & Science Museum**, a world-class, Smithsonian-affiliated aerospace and science museum with over 100 air and space artifacts, inspiring interactive exhibits, full-motion flight simulators, and indoor amusement rides, before heading back to Pittsburgh. (CB)

### **Walking Code: 3**

This tour includes moderate physical activity. The itinerary blends some longer days with shorter days and more leisure time. Walking tours, as well as walking slightly longer distances, up stairs or on uneven walking surfaces should be expected.
