Day 2: Visit the **National Museum of American History**, which is part of the Smithsonian Museum, and the **National Cathedral** today. This evening enjoy a **dinner cruise on the Potomac River**. (CB,D)

Day 3: Enjoy a **guided tour of DC's iconic monuments**, including the **Lincoln Memorial, Vietnam Veterans Memorial, Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial**, and the **Washington Monument**. Travel to our first president, **George Washington's home, Mount Vernon**. Lunch is included at **Mount Vernon Inn's restaurant**. Overnight in **Williamsburg, VA**. (CB,L)
