Afterwards, partake in a **tour & tasting at Ole Smoky Moonshine Museum & Distillery**. This afternoon, visit **The Dolly Parton Experience** in Dollywood, which spans her iconic career. Day 4: Travel to Oak Ridge, TN and experience a "Secret City" Tour: Oak Ridge's pivotal role in **WWII and the Manhattan Project**.
