

**Day 1:** Treat yourself to a relaxing night at **Tara ~ A Country Inn**, located in **Clark, PA**. This charming property, **themed after the movie Gone with the Wind**, reflects the golden days of the antebellum South. Tara will offer a lasting impression of Southern hospitality. It is the ultimate in World Class Country Inns, with luxurious guestrooms with such names as *Rhett Butler's Room*, *Fiddle Dee Dee* and *I'll Think about It Tomorrow*.

Before arriving at Tara, stop at **Daffin's Candies**, where chocolate reigns supreme. See their fantasyland of chocolate characters. Next, **tour the Buhl Mansion Guesthouse & Spa in Sharon, PA**, built by steel magnate Frank H. Buhl as a 1890s wedding gift for his wife Julia. It is a Richardsonian Romanesque masterpiece "castle" listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Enjoy an **afternoon tea** at Tara before a **delicious dinner**. (T,D)

**Day 2:** Visit **Kraynak's Flower Boutique & Greenhouses in Hermitage**. Time to enjoy the themed Christmas tree displays and shopping. Enjoy a visit and shopping at **Wendell August Forge**. Crafted by artisans in Pennsylvania for nearly a century, Wendell August gifts are unique symbols of the stories, traditions and milestones that bind us together. Each piece is hand-wrought using an eight-step process with roots in ancient metalworking techniques. (B)

Some of the touring days may be longer, with select included activities occurring later in the evening.

**Please note:** *Tara does not have an elevator. Please request a first floor room when making your deposit if you cannot climb stairs. There are a limited number of 1st floor rooms. However, the dining section of the hotel is on the bottom floor which requires using the stairs.*

**If you cannot climb these stairs, go to the Registration Desk and go out the door. Follow the bricks to the end of the walk by the Carriage House. Go through the burgundy door marked "Guest Registration". There is a ramp inside.**

**Rooms at Tara do not have two beds. We can request a room with a queen bed and sofa bed. Please let us know when booking if this is needed as there are a limited number of rooms with sofa**

**Insurance:** Travel insurance is optional. To be eligible for the waiver of pre-existing medical condition exclusion, the protection plan must be purchased within 21 days from the time you make your initial deposit and for the prepaid non-refundable payments or deposits. If purchased, the insurance premium is refundable during the 21-day review period, unless you have filed a claim or departed on your trip.
